**Objectives** | There is a transition underway in education in the schools on St Eustatius & Saba. The switch to English as a language of instruction on Statia has seen the status of Dutch being reinvented as a strong foreign language. This implies that there is a need for an approach which is based on the didactics of foreign language teaching.
