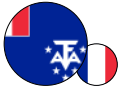

Location | The TAAF consist of Crozet islands, Kerguelen, St. Paul and Amsterdam islands (in the subantarctic zone), Adélie Land (Antarctica), and the Scattered islands (Europa, Glorioso, Juan de Nova, Bassas da India and Tromelin in the Indian Ocean).

**Project name** | ITAGED - Conservation of threatened top marine predators of the French Southern Territories: Identifying Threats and Getting Essential Data

**Budget** | € 163 366

**Duration** | 01/02/2018 – 31/01/2019

**Objectives** | The aim of the project was to improve the knowledge and conservation status of pelagic ecosystems in the Southern Ocean, to evaluate the impact of the projected climate changes for marine biodiversity, and to effectively prioritise the protection of the Southern Ocean

**Project name** | INSP-OI2 (new initiative for fisheries surveillance in the Southwest Indian Ocean - Part II)

**Budget** | € 346 441

**Duration** | 01/01/2017 – 30/06/2018

**Objectives** | It allowed for regional cooperation in the field of fisheries surveillance and fight against illegal fishing in the Southwest Indian Ocean. It is closely linked to the SmartFish programme of the Indian Ocean Commission (IOC) and aims to perpetuate participation of France-Réunion in a regional plan of fisheries surveillance.
